# How subjects work in the junior school

## <u>Year 7</u>

In Year 7 students all take Religious Education (R.E.), English, Maths, Science, Technology, Social Studies, Music and PE and Health throughout the year.

They will also take half a year each of Te Reo Maori and Japanese and one term each of Drama, Dance, Art and Project Based Learning.

For their subject classes students are placed in a core class which will be different from their form class. Core classes may change from year to year whereas students will stay in the same form class for pastoral care, from Year 7 to Year 13.

### <u>Year 8</u>

In Year 8 students all take Religious Education (R.E.), English, Maths, Science, Technology, Social Studies and PE and Health throughout the year.

They will also take half a year each of Te Reo Maori and either Japanese or French and one term each of Drama, Dance, Art and Music.

## Year 9

In Year 9 students all take Religious Education (R.E.), English, Maths, Science, Technology, Social Studies and PE and Health throughout the year.

They will also take a language of their choice (numbers permitting) for the year and one term each of Drama, Dance, Art and Music.

#### <u>Year 10</u>

In Year 10 students all take Religious Education (R.E.), English, Maths, Science, Social Studies and PE and Health throughout the year.

In addition they choose three option subjects to study for the year. These include languages, technologies and the arts.
