Principal's Awards

Traffic Safety on Swanson Road

As you may be aware, traffic congestion around our school has become heavier over recent years. This has become increasingly more serious along Swanson Road at peak times and is creating an issue for our students crossing the road as they walk home or make their way to the Sturges Road Train Station. Following many phone calls from concerned members of the public, as well as observations from our Senior Management Team, we have now directed our students to cross the road at the traffic/pedestrian lights before and after school. Due to the high number of students from our and other neighbouring schools crossing the road, it has become incredibly unsafe for them to use the 'island' outside the station itself. This is not a pedestrian crossing. We have been in contact with the Police and local council to improve the road safety for our children in this area and are awaiting their response. Please remind your children to use the traffic/pedestrian lights, so they remain safe. Thank you.

On Wednesday 22nd May at 7pm, we will be holding our Whanau consultation evening and warmly invite all our Māori families to attend. Brother Guy

Last week our Year 13 students, along with all Year 13 students in Catholic Secondary schools in Auckland, were invited by Bishop Pat Dunn to attend a presentation by Brother Guy Consolmagno. Brother Guy is a Jesuit priest and research astronomer, employed by Pope Francis as the Director of the Observatory within the Vatican. I would like to share a small piece of this talk with you as I found him incredibly inspiring, particularly in a time when our young people are trying so desperately to identify connections in their learning and make sense of our world.

Brother Guy spoke about the clear and unquestionable connection between *Science* and our *Faith*. On explaining how one does not exist without the other, he described the science behind a sunset, explaining how energy sources and the power of light enable us to see a sunrise over the horizon. He went on to explain that although its appearance can be explained by science and scientific formula, science does not explain why it is beautiful.
