St Dominic's College Sacramental Programme

At St Dominic's College we provide a programme each year for those wishing to receive the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation).

The normal place for the reception of these sacraments is the Parish. However, if for some reason, students have missed out on the Parish programme or alternatively, if you are not a Catholic family, and you wish your daughter to take part in this programme she is welcome to join the St Dominic's programme run by the Chaplain, Religious Education staff and LOGOS, a Marist Youth Ministry team,

While the students must freely choose to join the programme, we do insist that once having opted in to it they complete all sessions, that will likely be held during school time toward the end of this year. There will be a cost involved.

Those who complete the programme will be invited to receive the sacraments and then potentially she will be offered an enrolment place.

Having received the Sacraments, the students would be expected to join a Parish community where they could regularly attend Mass and take part in Catholic life.
